# A Bill

**HOUSE BILL 1095**

## For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE 7-7-305(c) CONCERNING THE  
9 USE OF A TITLE AS PART OF A CANDIDATE'S NAME ON A BALLOT;  
10 AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

11

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

13

14 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 7-7-305(c) is amended to read as follows:

15 "(c) Any person who shall file for any elective office in this state  
16 may use not more than three (3) given names, one of which may be a nickname or  
17 any other word used for the purpose of identifying such person to the voters  
18 and may add as a prefix to his name *the title* or an abbreviation of an  
19 elective public office the person holds. The name of every candidate shall be  
20 printed on the ballot in the same form as the candidate signed the political  
21 practice pledge. No candidate shall be permitted to change the form in which  
22 his name will be printed on the ballot after the deadline for filing the  
23 political practice pledge."

25 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature  
26 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code  
27 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

28

29 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to  
30 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect  
31 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without  
32 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this  
33 act are declared to be severable.

35 SECTION 4. All laws or parts of laws in conflict with this act are

1 hereby repealed.
