HOUSE BILL 1159

For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO AMEND TITLE 21, CHAPTER 4, SUBCHAPTER TWO OF
9 THE ARKANSAS CODE OF 1987, AS AMENDED, TO PERMIT THE
10 DONATION OF ANNUAL LEAVE DAYS TO A FELLOW EMPLOYEE
11 SUFFERING FROM A LONG-TERM ILLNESS; AND FOR OTHER
12 PURPOSES."

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

16 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 21-4-204(f) is hereby amended to read as
17 follows:

18 "(f) (1) Unearned annual leave shall not be loaned or donated.

19 (2) The minimum charge for absence on account of annual leave shall be
20 one (1) hour.

21 (3) *Any employee of the State may donate one or more days of annual
22 leave to another state employee whose sick and annual leave has been exhausted
23 while suffering from a long-term illness.*

24 (4) *Annual leave donated shall be in increments of eight-hour days
25 only.*

26 (5) *The donation of annual leave shall be approved by the Office of
27 Personnel Management under such rules as the Office of Personnel Management
28 shall promulgate, including but not limited to, number of hours to be donated,
29 definition of long term illness and procedure for approval of the donation."*

31 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
32 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
33 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

35 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to

1 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
2 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
3 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
4 act are declared to be severable.

6 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
7 hereby repealed.
