HOUSE BILL 1266

For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO AMEND TITLE 24, CHAPTER 12, SUBCHAPTER 1 OF THE
9 ARKANSAS CODE OF 1987 TO PROVIDE RETIREMENT BENEFITS TO
10 RECORDER-TREASURERS AND CITY TREASURERS OF CITIES OF THE
11 SECOND CLASS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

15 SECTION 1. Title 24, Chapter 12, Subchapter 1 of the Arkansas Code of
16 1987 is hereby amended by adding the following new section:

17 "24-12-127. Recorder-treasurers and city treasurers of second class.

18 (a) Any recorder-treasurers and city treasurers in a city of the second
19 class who shall have served as recorder-treasurer and city treasurer for a
20 period of not less than ten (10) years, upon reaching the age of sixty (60)
21 years, or who shall serve twenty (20) years without regard to age, *may, upon a*
22 *vote of approval by the governing body of the city,* retire from office for the
23 remainder of his or her life at the retirement pay provided for in this
24 section.

25 (b) (1) Any recorder-treasurer or city treasurer or any person serving
26 as recorder-treasurer or city treasurer who shall retire, or be succeeded by
27 another recorder-treasurer or city treasurer within the provisions of this
28 section shall be paid monthly a sum equal to one-half (1/2) of the monthly
29 salary received by him during the last preceding year of his service.

30 (2) The retirement pay shall be paid by the city from its general
31 fund account."

33 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
34 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
35 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this act are declared to be severable.

SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are hereby repealed.
