HOUSE BILL

For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO PROVIDE RECIPROCITY TO STATES WHICH DO NOT
9 REQUIRE NON-RESIDENT HUNTING AND FISHING LICENSES FOR
10 SENIOR CITIZENS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

13

14 SECTION 1. (a) Any non-resident, sixty-five (65) years of age or
15 older, whose home state does not require non-resident fishing or hunting
16 licenses for persons sixty-five (65) years of age and older, shall not be
17 required to purchase a non-resident fishing or hunting license to lawfully
18 hunt or fish in this state, provided, that person possesses a valid hunting or
19 fishing license issued by their home state for the species of fish or game
20 they are attempting to take.

21 (b) The Arkansas State Game and Fish Commission is authorized to enter
22 into reciprocity agreements with other states and issue necessary rules and
23 regulations for the implementation of this act.

25 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
26 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
27 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

28

29 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
30 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
31 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
32 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
33 act are declared to be severable.

35 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are

1 hereby repealed.
