HOUSE BILL 1344

For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR PERSONAL SERVICES AND
9 OPERATING EXPENSES OF THE ARKANSAS STATE HIGHWAY AND
10 TRANSPORTATION DEPARTMENT FOR THE BIENNIAL PERIOD ENDING
11 JUNE 30, 1993; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

16 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES. There is hereby established for the
17 Arkansas State Highway & Transportation Department, for the biennial period
18 ending June 30, 1993, the following maximum number of regular employees and
19 the maximum annual salary for such employees; and no greater salary than that
20 established herein shall be paid to any employee from appropriations
21 hereinafter made for said Department. The annual salaries to be paid to each
22 employee authorized herein shall be determined by the Arkansas Highway
23 Commission within the limitations as set out in this Section and the funds and
24 the appropriations made available for such purposes. All positions established
25 herein shall be exempt from the provisions of the Uniform Personnel
26 Classification and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201 et seq.), or its
27 successor, but shall not be exempt from the provisions of the Regular Salaries
28 Procedures and Restrictions Act. Provided further that the salaries for the
29 pay periods beginning June 27, 1991, and June 25, 1992, can be paid from the
30 salaries and overtime authorized for the fiscal years ending June 30, 1992 and
31 June 30, 1993 respectively.

SECTION 8. OVERTIME. The Arkansas Highway Commission is hereby authorized to pay overtime to its employees, and the administration thereof shall be in accordance with the policies established by the Commission. The executives and administrators of the Department shall be exempt from overtime payments as will certain professional employees occupying positions specifically exempt under the overtime policies established by the Commission.

For the purpose of paying overtime, any portion of Item 2 of Section 2 may be transferred to and be combined with Item 1 (Salaries) in Section 2 at the discretion of the Highway Commission and notice to the Auditor of State and the Director of Finance and Administration. Thereafter, overtime applicable to salaries may be paid from Item 1 of Section 2. One state warrant may be issued to each employee for the total of the regular salaries and overtime earned. The amount of the line items in Section 1 authorized for ~~salaries, may be exceeded for employees eligible for overtime to the extent of~~ the overtime paid to said employees. Overtime thus paid shall be identifiable for each employee, and in total for all employees, on the voucher or other record that is submitted to support the issuance of payroll warrants.

SECTION 9. TRANSFERS AUTHORIZED. Any savings in the amount appropriated in Section 2 for Item (1) Salaries, Item (2) Overtime, Item (3) Personal Services Matching, or any sub-item of Item (4) Maintenance, Operation, Construction, etc., may be transferred by the Director of the State Highway and Transportation Department to any sub-item of Item (4), by notifying the Director of Finance and Administration and the Auditor of State

1 to transfer said savings to a specific sub-item of Item (4) and make it
2 available for said purpose during the then current fiscal year.

3

4 SECTION 10. SOCIAL SECURITY AND RETIREMENT. The State Highway and
5 Transportation Department's expenses for Social Security Matching and
6 administrative costs thereof are to paid to the Social Security Matching Fund,
7 in accordance with the regulations or instructions of the Department of
8 Finance and Administration. The State Highway and Transportation Department's
9 expenses for Highway Retirement Matching shall be paid to the State Highway
10 Employees Retirement System, in accordance with the instructions of said
11 system, as directed by the State Highway Commission.

13 SECTION 11. PERSONAL SERVICES MATCHING TRANSFER. Provided that in the
14 event amounts appropriated in Item (3) Section 2, Personal Services Matching,
15 are insufficient in either year of the biennium to pay the amounts at the
16 rates stipulated by law to be paid for each of these items, an additional
17 amount as determined and requested by the Director of Highways and
18 Transportation will be transferred by the Director of Finance and
19 Administration and the Auditor of State from Item (4) Maintenance, Operation,
20 Construction, Reconstruction, etc., to Item (3) in Section 2, to enable the
21 State Highway and Transportation Department to pay the required matching
22 funds.

23

24 SECTION 12. UNIFORM ALLOWANCE. The Arkansas Highway Commission is
25 hereby authorized to pay from funds appropriated for Maintenance and Operation
26 a uniform allowance of Twelve Hundred Dollars (\$1,200) per annum for all
27 uniformed personnel (Arkansas Highway Police Patrolman through Chief, Police
28 Division) of the Arkansas Highway Police Division. The above mentioned
29 allowance shall be equated to and paid at the rate of One Hundred Dollars
30 (\$100) per month for each month of the employment for those eligible personnel
31 of the Arkansas Highway Police Division. Provided further, that when
32 uniformed personnel are hired, they shall be paid an initial lump-sum uniform
33 allowance of Two Hundred Dollars (\$200) that shall be in addition to the
34 monthly allowance as herein provided.

35

1 SECTION 13. TOOL ALLOWANCE. The Arkansas Highway Commission is hereby
2 authorized to pay from funds appropriated for Maintenance and Operation a tool
3 allowance of Two Hundred Forty Dollars (\$240) per annum for each Mechanic,
4 Electric, Plumbing, and Mechanical Repairer, Welder, or Body Repairer and
5 Painter employed by the State Highway and Transportation Department who work
6 on Highway equipment and facilities. The aforementioned allowance shall be
7 equated to Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) per month for each month of employment for
8 the eligible personnel of this department.

9

10 SECTION 14. LIABILITY INSURANCE PREMIUM REIMBURSEMENT. The Arkansas
11 Highway Commission is hereby authorized to reimburse from funds appropriated
12 in Item (4) of Section 2 of this Act, State Highway and Transportation
13 Department employees for personal liability insurance premiums paid by State
14 Highway and Transportation Department employees for liability coverage on
15 state owned vehicles of the Highway and Transportation Department up to a
16 maximum of Fifty Dollars (\$50) per annum per employee, at the option of the
17 eligible employee. The Arkansas Highway Department is hereby authorized to
18 pay for amounts not to exceed \$25,000 per claim for damages to personal
19 property of others resulting from the operation of any motor vehicle or other
20 motorized equipment of the Department upon determination by the State Claims
21 Commission that the claim is valid after hearing the facts thereof and after
22 prior review by the Legislative Claims Committee and Legislative Council.

23

24 SECTION 15. MOVING EXPENSE. The Arkansas Highway Commission is hereby
25 authorized to pay from funds appropriated from Maintenance and Operation the
26 actual expense of moving the household and personal property of those
27 employees of the Department who, because of their job assignment, are required
28 to move their place of residence by the Highway Commission, through the
29 Director, subject to the approval by the Director, for each move so required.

30

31 SECTION 16. DISBURSING PROCEDURE. The designated Disbursing Officers
32 for the Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department are hereby
33 authorized to complete and sign one certification for each State Voucher or
34 other designated document that authorizes the Auditor of State, or other
35 official, to draw a state warrant or check on a fund administered by the State

1 Highway and Transportation Department. The voucher or other authorizing
2 document can consist of one or more pages and in the event that more than one
3 page is used, then the designated Disbursing Officer is to manually sign the
4 last page only, and any certification is to be so worded that it will apply to
5 all pages of the document.

6
7 SECTION 17. SPECIAL ALLOWANCE. Due to his exacting and special duties,
8 the Director of the Highway and Transportation Department is hereby authorized
9 an expense allowance of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500) per month upon approval of
10 the Highway Commission. The Arkansas Highway Commission shall provide for an
11 expense allowance of up to Two Thousand Dollars (\$2,000) per annum for each
12 Chief, Captain, First Lieutenant, Second Lieutenant, Sergeant, Corporal,
13 Patrolman First Class and Patrolman of the Arkansas Highway Police.

14
15 SECTION 18. UNEMPLOYMENT BENEFITS. The Arkansas State Highway and
16 Transportation Department is authorized to pay from Item (3) of Section 2
17 hereof, the Unemployment Benefits and Workers Compensation Benefits, at a rate
18 not in excess of the Agency's experience rate, under the provisions of
19 regulations established by the Department of Finance and Administration.

20
21 SECTION 19. TRANSFER PROVISION. Provided, that any unexpended
22 appropriation balance, remaining on June 30, 1992, in the appropriation
23 authorized in Section 2 hereof, for Item (1) Regular Salaries; Item (2)
24 Overtime Compensation; Item (3) Personal Services Matching; and Item (4)
25 Maintenance, Operations, Construction, and other items shall be transferred by
26 the Chief Fiscal Officer and the Auditor of State to Item (4) (A) Oper.
27 Expenses in Section 2 hereof, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1992 and
28 ending June 30, 1993, and made available for use in said year, and that any
29 unexpended appropriation balance made herein for Highway Special Construction,
30 Federal Highway Trust, State Aid Roads and Highway Safety Special remaining on
31 June 30, 1992 shall be transferred forward by the Chief Fiscal Officer and the
32 Auditor of State to the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1992, and ending June
33 30, 1993, and made available for the same purposes.

34
35 SECTION 20. REPORTING REQUIREMENTS. The Arkansas Highway Commission is

1 hereby authorized to take appropriate action as necessary to restrict or
2 reduce the operating, administration, and other associated costs of the State
3 Highway and Transportation Department, including the Arkansas Highway Police
4 Division, for the biennial period ending June 30, 1993. Provided further,
5 that the Arkansas Highway Commission is directed to furnish the Arkansas
6 Legislative Council with an expenditure status report regarding the financial
7 activities of the State Highway and Transportation Department at least
8 quarterly, beginning no later than September 30, 1989.

9

10 SECTION 21. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds
11 authorized by this Act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency
12 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and
13 the restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and
14 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
15 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control
16 laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the
17 Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
18 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

19

20 SECTION 22. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
21 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
22 contained in this Act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which
23 this Act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
24 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
25 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
26 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
27 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

28

29 SECTION 23. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and
30 permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and
31 the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

32

33 SECTION 24. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the
34 application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such
35 invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which

1 can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this
2 end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.

3

4 SECTION 25. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict
5 with this Act are hereby repealed.

6

7 SECTION 26. HEALTH PREMIUMS. The Arkansas State Highway and
8 Transportation Department shall not, during the 1992-93 fiscal year, spend
9 more for health insurance per employee than the amount being contributed to
10 the State Employees Health Insurance Program.

11

12 SECTION 27. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the
13 Seventy-Eighth General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of
14 Arkansas prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year
15 period; that the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 1991 is essential to the
16 operation of the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided,
17 and that in the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the
18 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 1991 could work irreparable harm
19 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental
20 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act
21 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
22 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 1991.
