HOUSE BILL 1391

For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE CITY OF WYNNE TO IMPOSE AN
9 ADDITIONAL COURT COST TO FUND LOCAL RETIREMENT FUNDS; AND
10 FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

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12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

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14 *SECTION 1. The governing body of the City of Wynne may levy and collect*
15 *from each defendant an additional court cost not to exceed three dollars*
16 *(\$3.00) for entering upon the records of the court each criminal case and each*
17 *moving traffic violation filed in the Wynne Municipal Court. The revenues*
18 *derived from the additional court costs shall be paid to the City Treasurer*
19 *for the sole purpose of payment of retirement benefits for personnel of the*
20 *Wynne Municipal Court.*

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22 *SECTION 2. The provisions of this act providing authority for an*
23 *increase in fees shall be retroactive to January 1, 1990.*

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25 *SECTION 3. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature*
26 *are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code*
27 *Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.*

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29 *SECTION 4. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to*
30 *any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect*
31 *other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without*
32 *the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this*
33 *act are declared to be severable.*

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35 *SECTION 5. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are*

1 hereby repealed.

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3 SECTION 6. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the
4 Seventy-Eighth General Assembly that certain local retirement funds for
5 municipal judges and court clerks need additional contributions; that an
6 increase in fees will prevent such municipalities from having to fund
7 retirements from their general revenues; that it is imperative that this act
8 become effective upon its passage and approval. Therefore, an emergency is
9 hereby declared to exist and this act being necessary for the immediate
10 preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and
11 effect from and after its passage and approval.
