HOUSE BILL 1518

For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE 21-5-203 TO PROVIDE FOR JOB
9 SHARING; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

13 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 21-5-203(10) is hereby amended to read as
14 follows:

15 "(10) 'Position' means an office or employment in an agency or
16 institution of higher education, occupied or vacant, involving duties
17 requiring the services of one (1) or two persons;"

19 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code 21-5-203 is hereby amended to add the
20 following new subsection:

21 "(19) 'Job Sharing' means a form of employment in which the hours of
22 work of two persons are arranged in such a way as to cover a single regular
23 full-time salary position. The Department of Finance and Administration may
24 authorize job sharing for all regular full-time salary positions. The
25 Director of the Department of Finance and Administration or his designee shall
26 promulgate necessary rules and regulations as deemed necessary to carry out
27 the provisions of this Act."

29 *SECTION 3. All rules and regulations promulgated pursuant to this act*
30 *shall be reviewed by the Joint Interim Committee on Public Health, Welfare and*
31 *Labor or an appropriate subcommittee thereof.*

33 SECTION 4. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent nature
34 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
35 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

SECTION 5. If any provision of this Act or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.

SECTION 6. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.
