HOUSE BILL

For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO REPEAL ARKANSAS CODE 19-3-401 THROUGH 403; AND
9 FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

13 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code §§ 19-3-401 through 403 are hereby repealed.

15 SECTION 2. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent nature
16 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
17 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

19 SECTION 3. If any provision of this Act or the application thereof to
20 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
21 other provisions or applications of the Act which can be given effect without
22 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
23 Act are declared to be severable.

25 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are
26 hereby repealed.

28 SECTION 5. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the
29 Seventy-Eighth General Assembly that Arkansas Code §§ 19-3-401 through 403 has
30 caused unnecessary hardship to cities, counties, and school districts and has
31 adversely affected the normal operation of these entities. Therefore, an
32 emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being immediately necessary
33 for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full
34 force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
