## **HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION**

8 THE ARKANSAS DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION VOCATIONAL-TECHNICAL  
9 DIVISION SHALL ADOPT AND IMPLEMENT IN THEIR CURRICULUM  
10 TRAINING NECESSARY FOR THE PROPER HANDLING, RECYCLING AND  
11 DISPOSAL OF CFC'S AND THE SIGNIFICANCE OF THE PROPER  
12 HANDLING OF CFC'S ON OUR ENVIRONMENT.

14 WHEREAS, the emissions of fully halogenated chlorofluorocarbons and  
15 halons can significantly deplete the ozone layer in a manner that is likely to  
16 result in adverse effects on human health and the environment, and

17 WHEREAS, CFC's are widely used in refrigerators and automobile air  
18 conditioners, and

19 WHEREAS, Vo-Tech trains many Arkansans for the professions which will  
20 deal with these substances, and

21 WHEREAS, the United States endorsement of the Montreal Protocol and the  
22 adoption of the 1990 Clean Air Act will greatly impact the future of these  
23 professions, and

24 WHEREAS, retraining will be required for people dealing with these  
25 products as substitutes are developed, and

26 WHEREAS, Vo-Techs can provide valuable information to businesses to  
27 ensure that CFC recycling is done properly.

28 WHEREAS, Vo-Tech will play a key role in ensuring that Arkansans are  
29 properly prepared for the significant changes which will occur in numerous  
30 industries in the state.

34 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE SEVENTY-EIGHTH GENERAL  
35 ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:

3 in their curriculum training necessary for the proper handling, recycling and  
4 disposal of CFC's and the significance of the proper handling of CFC's on our  
5 environment.
