## **HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION**

7 REQUESTING THE JOINT INTERIM COMMITTEE ON STATE AGENCIES  
8 AND GOVERNMENTAL AFFAIRS TO CONDUCT A STUDY CONCERNING  
9 THE REPAIR OF THE EAST STEPS OF THE CAPITOL.

11 WHEREAS, the Arkansas State Capitol Building is the center of the  
12 government of the State of Arkansas;

14 WHEREAS, the Arkansas State Capitol is also a historic landmark and is  
15 visited by many people each day;

17 WHEREAS, the people of the State of Arkansas take pride in their State  
18 Capitol Building;

20 WHEREAS, the main steps to the capitol on the east side of the building  
21 have begun to deteriorate and are in need of significant repair;

22

23 WHEREAS, the steps should be repaired at the earliest possible time to  
24 avoid additional damage and to avoid possible safety problems,

26 NOW THEREFORE,

27 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE SEVENTY-EIGHTH GENERAL  
28 ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:

30 WHEREAS, That the Joint Interim Committee on State Agencies and Governmental  
31 Affairs is requested to conduct a study of the need for repairs to the main  
32 steps of the State Capitol on the east side of the Capitol Building. The  
33 purpose of the study shall be to make recommendations to the General Assembly  
34 and the Secretary of State on the type of repairs that should be undertaken to

1 best preserve the State Capitol steps.
