7 **HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION**

8 REQUESTING THE JOINT INTERIM COMMITTEE ON STATE AGENCIES
9 AND GOVERNMENTAL AFFAIRS TO CONDUCT A STUDY CONCERNING
10 THE REPAIR OF THE EAST STEPS OF THE CAPITOL.

12 WHEREAS, the Arkansas State Capitol Building is the center of the
13 government of the State of Arkansas;

14

15 WHEREAS, the Arkansas State Capitol is also a historic landmark and is
16 visited by many people each day;

17

18 WHEREAS, the people of the State of Arkansas take pride in their State
19 Capitol Building;

20

21 WHEREAS, the main steps to the capitol on the east side of the building
22 have begun to deteriorate and are in need of significant repair;

23

24 WHEREAS, the steps should be repaired at the earliest possible time to
25 avoid additional damage and to avoid possible safety problems,

27 NOW THEREFORE,

28 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE SEVENTY-EIGHTH GENERAL
29 ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:

31 That the Joint Interim Committee on State Agencies and Governmental
32 Affairs is requested to conduct a study of the need for repairs to the main
33 steps of the State Capitol on the east side of the Capitol Building. The
34 purpose of the study shall be to make recommendations to the General Assembly
35 and the Secretary of State on the type of repairs that should be undertaken to

1 best preserve the State Capitol steps.
