**HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION**

8 TO ALLOW REPRESENTATIVES FOSTER, HAWKINS, LANDERS, TURNER,  
9 CALHOUN, AND S. MILLER TO INTRODUCE A BILL TO ESTABLISH  
10 AGE FIFTY-TWO (52) AS THE MINIMUM RETIREMENT AGE FOR A  
11 DEPUTY SHERIFF WITH TWENTY-FIVE (25) YEARS OF SERVICE.

13 WHEREAS, Arkansas Code 10-2-115 provides that proposed legislation  
14 affecting publicly supported retirement systems or pension plans shall be  
15 introduced during the first thirty (30) calendar days of a regular session;  
16 and

17 WHEREAS, that section of the Arkansas Code allows such bills to be  
18 introduced after the thirtieth day upon a vote of two-thirds (2/3) of the full  
19 membership of each house of the General Assembly;

21 NOW THEREFORE,

22 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE SEVENTY-EIGHTH GENERAL  
23 ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:

25 That Representatives Foster, Hawkins, Landers, Turner, Calhoun, and S.  
26 Miller are authorized to introduce a bill to establish age fifty-two (52) as  
27 the minimum retirement age for a deputy sheriff with twenty-five (25) years of  
28 service.
