7 **HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION**

8 REQUESTING THE JOINT INTERIM OVERSIGHT SUBCOMMITTEE ON  
9 EDUCATIONAL REFORM TO MONITOR IMPLEMENTATION OF ARKANSAS  
10 HISTORY CURRICULUM AND TO REPORT TO THE JOINT INTERIM  
11 COMMITTEE ON EDUCATION.

14 WHEREAS, Arkansas Code §6-16-109 requires the teaching of Arkansas  
15 history in the public schools of this state; and

17 WHEREAS, provisions have been made for the establishment of a revolving  
18 fund under Arkansas Code §6-20-205 to expedite the purchase of Arkansas  
19 history textbooks by school districts in this state; and

21 WHEREAS, a firm education in our state heritage is an integral part of  
22 properly educating the children of this state;

25 NOW THEREFORE,

26 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE SEVENTY-EIGHTH GENERAL  
27 ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:

29 THAT the Joint Interim Oversight Subcommittee on Educational Reform of  
30 the Joint Interim Committee on Education monitor the implementation of  
31 curricula concerning Arkansas history in the public school districts of this  
32 state; and

34 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that such subcommittee report the progress made  
35 in implementing Arkansas history curricula in the public schools of this state

1 to the Joint Interim Committee on Education by July 1, 1992.
