## **HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION**

8           REQUESTING THE JOINT INTERIM COMMITTEE ON PUBLIC  
9           TRANSPORTATION TO STUDY THE LAWS CONCERNING DRIVING WHILE  
10           INTOXICATED TO DETERMINE THE DESIRABILITY OF REVISING  
11           THOSE LAWS TO ASSURE THAT THE PURPOSES OF THE LAWS ARE  
12           ACCOMPLISHED.

14           WHEREAS, driving a motor vehicle while under the influence of alcoholic  
15 beverages or drugs constitutes a serious threat to the safety of all citizens  
16 of this state;

17           WHEREAS, the number of arrests for driving while intoxicated continues  
18 to rise;

19           WHEREAS, the number of fatal accidents due to driving while intoxicated  
20 also continues to rise; and

21           WHEREAS, a study needs to be conducted to determine if the driving  
22 while intoxicated laws of the state are sufficient and are being strictly  
23 enforced;

25 NOW THEREFORE,

26 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE SEVENTY-EIGHTH GENERAL  
27 ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:

29           THAT the Joint Interim Committee on Public Transportation is requested  
30 to conduct a study of the driving while intoxicated laws of this state to  
31 determine if the laws are sufficient and are being enforced by law enforcement  
32 officers and the judicial system to the fullest extent possible.
