HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

7 REQUESTING A STUDY BY THE JOINT INTERIM COMMITTEE ON
8 AGRICULTURE AND ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT ON THE LAWS
9 CONCERNING FERAL HOGS TO DETERMINE WHETHER THESE LAWS NEED
10 TO BE REVISED.

13 WHEREAS, the existing state law clearly defines feral hogs as domestic
14 and outlines all elements of its existence in regard to free roaming, strays
15 and posting of notification for rightful ownership; and

16

17 WHEREAS, there is growing concern among land, wildlife, and forest
18 managers, the state's livestock industry, and the scientific community
19 concerning the potential negative impacts of wild hog populations on human and
20 livestock disease transmission, agricultural crops, wildlife and wildlife food
21 resources, reforestation and natural plant communities; and

22

23 WHEREAS, free roaming feral hogs have caused and continue to cause
24 depredation problems on certain forest tree seedlings, agricultural crops,
25 rangelands, lawns, golf courses, and disruption to natural plant communities
26 through rooting, wallowing and trailing; and

27

28 WHEREAS, the sportsman's presence in wildlife areas of the state, in
29 search of feral hogs has caused and will continue to generate numerous legal
30 questions in regard to direct violations of existing wildlife regulations and
31 the antiquated state laws governing feral hogs; and

32

33 WHEREAS, the Arkansas Game and Fish Commission, through Amendment 35 to
34 the Arkansas Constitution, has stewardship obligations to minimize wildlife

1 related conflicts, damages and hazards in the area of public and domestic
2 animal health and welfare.

5 NOW THEREFORE,

6 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE SEVENTY-EIGHTH GENERAL
7 ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:

9 THAT the Joint Interim Committee on Agriculture and Economic Development
10 conduct a study on the laws concerning feral hogs and undertake efforts to
11 modernize these outdated laws by repealing or amending them.

12

13 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT the committee report its findings prior to
14 the convening of the 79th Regular Session of the Arkansas General Assembly.
