8 IN APPRECIATION OF FORMER SECRETARY OF STATE ALEX C. HULL
9 AND HIS GRANDSON, RODNEY WORTHINGTON OF LITTLE ROCK, AN
10 EMPLOYEE OF THE CURRENT SECRETARY OF STATE.

13 WHEREAS, Mr. Alex C. Hull served as Secretary of State of the Great
14 State of Arkansas from 1897 to 1901; and

16 WHEREAS, Mr. Hull in 1899 made the suggestion to build a new state
17 Capitol, the magnificent structure we now occupy; and

19 WHEREAS, Mr. Hull formulated a plan to utilize the location of the old
20 state penitentiary as the site for the new Capitol and to use inmate labor in
21 the construction of the building; and

23 WHEREAS, The grandson of Mr. Hull, Rodney Worthington of Little Rock, a
24 photographer employed by the current Secretary of State, W. J. "Bill" McCuen,
25 has served the 78th General Assembly with distinction,
