7 **HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION**

8 PROVIDING FOR THE EXTENSION OF THE REGULAR SESSION OF THE
9 SEVENTY-EIGHTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY TO PERMIT COMPLETION OF
10 THE BUSINESS OF THE SESSION AND TO ESTABLISH PROCEDURES
11 FOR THE ORDERLY COMPLETION OF THE BUSINESS OF THE SESSION.

13 WHEREAS, Section 17 of Article V of the Constitution of the state of
14 Arkansas provides that the regular biennial session of the General Assembly
15 shall not exceed sixty days in duration, unless by a vote of two-thirds of the
16 members elected to each house of the General Assembly; and

17 WHEREAS, the regular session of the Seventy-Eighth General Assembly was
18 extended to Friday March 22, but it now appears that it will be impossible to
19 complete the essential business of this session within that time and that a
20 further extension of this regular session will be necessary to enable the
21 Seventy-Eighth General Assembly to complete its business,

23 NOW THEREFORE,

24 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE SEVENTY-EIGHTH GENERAL
25 ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:

26 SECTION 1. The regular session of the Seventy-Eighth General Assembly
27 of the state of Arkansas is hereby extended until the completion of business
28 in each house on April 15, 1991.

29 SECTION 2. The Seventy-Eighth General Assembly shall recess at the
30 close of business on March 27, 1991, to reconvene at 12:00 noon on Monday,
31 April 15 for the purpose of considering vetoes and correcting errors or
32 oversights in appropriations, unless the President Pro Tem of the Senate and
33 the Speaker of the House of Representatives, by joint proclamation, determine
34 that reconvening of the Seventy-Eighth General Assembly on that date is
35 unnecessary, in which event any five members of each house may adjourn the
