7 **HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION**

8 FOR A PROPOSED CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT TO ABOLISH THE
9 OFFICE OF CONSTABLE.

11 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE SEVENTY-EIGHTH GENERAL
12 ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS AND BY THE SENATE, A MAJORITY OF ALL MEMBERS
13 ELECTED TO EACH HOUSE AGREEING THERETO:

15 That the following is hereby proposed as an amendment to the Constitution
16 of the state of Arkansas, and upon being submitted to the electors of the
17 state for approval or rejection at the next general election for
18 Representatives and Senators, if a majority of the electors voting thereon at
19 such election, adopt such amendment, the same shall become a part of the
20 Constitution of the state of Arkansas, to wit:

22 SECTION 1. Article 7, Section 47 of the Arkansas Constitution is
23 repealed and the office of constable is abolished.

25 SECTION 2. The provisions of this amendment shall be effective January
26 1, 1994.
