HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION

7 FOR A PROPOSED CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT TO PROVIDE FOR
8 ANNUAL SESSIONS OF THE ARKANSAS GENERAL ASSEMBLY.

10 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE SEVENTY-EIGHTH GENERAL
11 ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS AND BY THE SENATE, A MAJORITY OF ALL MEMBERS
12 ELECTED TO EACH HOUSE AGREEING THERETO:

14 That the following is hereby proposed as an amendment to the Constitution
15 of the state of Arkansas, and upon being submitted to the electors of the
16 state for approval or rejection at the next general election for
17 Representatives and Senators, if a majority of the electors voting thereon at
18 such election, adopt such amendment, the same shall become a part of the
19 Constitution of the state of Arkansas, to wit:

21 "SECTION 1. (a) In addition to the regular biennial session of the
22 Arkansas General Assembly held each odd-numbered year, the General Assembly
23 shall meet in an additional regular session each even numbered-year.

24 (b) The additional session held in even-numbered years shall begin on
25 the fourth Monday in January. The session shall not exceed thirty (30) days
26 unless extended by a vote of two-thirds of the members elected to each house
27 of the General Assembly. Bills may be prefiled beginning on January 1 of the
28 year and no bill shall be introduced after the beginning of the session held
29 in even-numbered years except by unanimous consent of all members of the
30 General Assembly. Committees of the House of Representative and Committees of
31 the Senate may meet beginning two weeks before the additional session held in
32 even-numbered year.

34 SECTION 2. Nothing in this Amendment shall apply to the conduct of

1 regular biennial sessions held in odd-numbered years."
