## **HOUSE MEMORIAL RESOLUTION**

8 IN RESPECTFUL MEMORY OF 1ST LT. ERIC D. HEDEEN, UNITED  
9 STATES AIR FORCE.

11 WHEREAS, 1st Lt. Eric D. Hedeen, 27, of Malaga, Washington, died on  
12 Saturday, February 2, 1991, as a crewman on a B-52 Bomber from Eaker Air Force  
13 Base, Blytheville, Arkansas, when it crashed in the Indian Ocean returning  
14 from a combat mission over IRAQ during OPERATION DESERT STORM; and

15 WHEREAS, 1st Lt. Eric D. Hedeen served the United States of America  
16 with distinction and gave his life, the ultimate sacrifice, to preserve and  
17 protect freedom and justice in the world from death, desolation and tyranny,

19 NOW THEREFORE,

20 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE SEVENTY-EIGHTH GENERAL  
21 ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

23 THAT this Resolution is adopted in respectful memory of 1st Lt. Eric D.  
24 Hedeen, and in recognition of the distinction with which he served the United  
25 States of America, and the honor he brought to the State of Arkansas while  
26 stationed at Eaker Air Force Base, Blytheville, Arkansas.

28 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that upon adoption of this Resolution, an  
29 appropriate Citation commending his service shall be transmitted to the family  
30 of 1st Lt. Eric D. Hedeen.
