7 **HOUSE RESOLUTION**

8 REQUESTING THE SECRETARY OF STATE TO IMMEDIATELY DISBAND
9 THE SECURITY SYSTEM INSTITUTED DURING THE PERSIAN GULF
10 WAR.

12 WHEREAS, as a security precaution the Secretary of State was requested
13 to institute a strict security program for the State Capitol Building during
14 the Persian Gulf War; and

15 WHEREAS, the President of the United States has now declared victory;
16 and

17 WHEREAS, the members of the House of Representatives, the Secretary of
18 State and a multitude of interest parties agree that the strict security
19 system is no longer necessary; and

20 WHEREAS, the disbanding of the security system will allow State Police
21 personnel and Secretary of State security personnel to return to their normal
22 duties;

24 NOW THEREFORE,

25 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE SEVENTY-EIGHTH GENERAL
26 ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

28 That the Secretary of State is hereby urged and requested to immediately
29 disband the State Capitol security system instituted during the Persian Gulf
30 War.
