7 **HOUSE RESOLUTION**

8 REQUESTING THE JOINT COMMITTEE ON ENERGY TO MAKE A STUDY
9 OF JAPAN'S ENERGY CONSERVATION POLICIES AND PRACTICES TO
10 DETERMINE IF IT WOULD BE PRACTICAL TO IMPLEMENT SUCH
11 POLICIES AND PRACTICES IN THIS COUNTRY AND STATE.

13 WHEREAS, Japan manufacturers approximately fifteen percent (15%) of the
14 products manufactured in the entire world yet uses only about five percent
15 (5%) of the total energy used in manufacturing; and

16 WHEREAS, the United States manufacturers about twenty-five percent (25%)
17 of the products manufactured in the entire world and uses approximately
18 twenty-five percent (25%) of the total energy used in manufacturing; and

19 WHEREAS, energy conservation should be a high priority of this state and
20 nation,

22 NOW THEREFORE,

23 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE SEVENTY-EIGHTH GENERAL
24 ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

26 SECTION 1. The Joint Committee on Energy is requested to make a study
27 of the energy conservation policies and practices of Japan to determine if it
28 is practical to adopt similar policies in this country and in the State of
29 Arkansas.

31 SECTION 2. The Committee shall report its findings and recommendations
32 to the Seventy-Ninth General Assembly.
