9 SECONDARY SCHOOL TEACHERS WHO RECEIVED AWARDS AT THE 1989-  
10 90 NATIONAL AWARDS PROGRAM FOR THE TEACHING OF ECONOMICS.

13 WHEREAS, twenty-one Arkansas elementary and secondary school teachers  
14 received awards at the 1989-90 National Awards Program for the Teaching of  
15 Economics; and

16 WHEREAS, these teachers represent excellence in the classroom; and

17 WHEREAS, these teachers now join three hundred and thirty-three other  
18 Arkansas teachers who are previous winners in this program over the past  
19 twenty-nine years; and

20 WHEREAS, Arkansas ranks number one in the nation in the number of  
21 teachers who have won national awards for the teaching of economics; and

22 WHEREAS, last year Arkansas was the only state in the nation with two  
23 first place winners;

26 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE SEVENTY-EIGHTH GENERAL  
27 ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
