10 COMMENDING COACH NELSON CATALINA AND THE ARKANSAS STATE UNIVERSITY
11 INDIAN BASKETBALL TEAM.

14 WHEREAS, the Arkansas State University Indian Men's Basketball Team,
15 coached by Coach Nelson Catalina, are co-champions of the American South
16 Conference; and

18 WHEREAS, the Indians received an invitation to participate in the
19 National Invitational Tournament and defeated Rice University in the first
20 round of the tournament; and

22 WHEREAS, the game against Rice University was played in Jonesboro before
23 a home crowd of 9,100 fans; and

25 WHEREAS, the Indians set a school record for the most wins in a regular
26 season with a record of 21 wins, 8 losses and also set the school record for
27 most wins in a season (22 wins) with their 78-71 victory over the Rice Owls;

30 WHEREAS, Coach Nelson Catalina's leadership and coaching abilities were
31 recognized by his being named Coach of the Year for the American South
32 Conference by both the media and the Coaches; and

34 WHEREAS, the ASU Indians will play their second game in the National
35 Invitational Tournament against Memphis State on Monday, March 18th;
