SENATE BILL

For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO REPEAL ARKANSAS CODE 7-1-103(26) WHICH
9 PROHIBITS THE SALE OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES ON ELECTION DAY;
10 AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

13 WHEREAS, during its 1989 Regular Session, the Arkansas General Assembly
14 passed Act 426 of 1989 to amend Arkansas Code 3-3-210 to eliminate the
15 language which prohibited the sale of alcoholic beverages on election days;
16 and

17 WHEREAS, since the passage of Act 426 it has been discovered that
18 Arkansas Code 7-1-103(26) also prohibits the sale of alcoholic beverages on
19 election days; and

20 WHEREAS, the Attorney General has issued an opinion that Act 426
21 impliedly repealed Arkansas Code 7-1-103(26); and

22 WHEREAS, in order to remove any confusion it is advisable to
23 specifically repeal that statute,

25 NOW THEREFORE,

26 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

27

28 SECTION 1. Paragraph (26) of Arkansas Code 7-1-103 is hereby repealed.

29

30 SECTION 2. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent nature
31 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
32 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

33

34 SECTION 3. If any provision of this Act or the application thereof to
35 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect

1 other provisions or applications of the Act which can be given effect without
2 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
3 Act are declared to be severable.

4

5 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are
6 hereby repealed.
