# A Bill

**SENATE BILL 335**

## For An Act To Be Entitled

7 "AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR PERSONAL SERVICES FOR  
8 THE OFFICE OF ATTORNEY GENERAL WHICH SHALL BE SUPPLEMENTAL  
9 AND IN ADDITION TO THOSE FUNDS APPROPRIATED BY ACT 46 OF  
10 THE FIRST EXTRAORDINARY SESSION OF 1989, FOR THE FISCAL  
11 YEAR ENDING JUNE 30, 1991; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

15 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES. There is hereby established for the  
16 Office of Attorney General for the 1989-91 biennium, the following maximum  
17 number of regular employees which shall be supplemental and in addition to  
18 those positions authorized in Section 1 of Act 46 of the First Extraordinary  
19 Session of 1989 and whose salaries shall be governed by the provisions of the  
20 Uniform Classification and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201 et  
21 seq.), or its successor, and all laws amendatory thereto. Provided, however,  
22 that any position to which a specific maximum annual salary is set out herein  
23 in dollars, shall be exempt from the provisions of said Uniform Classification  
24 and Compensation Act. All persons occupying positions authorized herein are  
25 hereby governed by the provisions of the Regular Salaries Procedures and  
26 Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-101), or its successor.

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5 SECTION 2. APPROPRIATIONS. There is hereby appropriated, to the Office  
6 of Attorney General, to be payable from the State Central Services Fund, for  
7 personal services of the Office of Attorney General which shall be  
8 supplemental and in addition to those funds appropriated in Section 3 of Act  
9 46 of the First Extraordinary Session of 1989, for the remainder of the fiscal  
10 year ending June 30, 1991, the following:

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18 SECTION 3. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds  
19 authorized by this Act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency  
20 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and  
21 the restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and  
22 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary  
23 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control  
24 laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the  
25 Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be  
26 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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28 SECTION 4. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General  
29 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations  
30 contained in this Act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which  
31 this Act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive  
32 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget  
33 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or  
34 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative  
35 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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1 SECTION 5. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent  
2 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas  
3 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

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5 SECTION 6. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the  
6 application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such  
7 invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which  
8 can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this  
9 end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.

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11 SECTION 7. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict  
12 with this Act are hereby repealed.

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14 SECTION 8. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the  
15 Seventy-Eighth General Assembly, that funds provided by the Seventy-Seventh  
16 General Assembly for the operations of the Office of Attorney General are, due  
17 to unforeseen circumstances, insufficient for the Office of Attorney General  
18 to continue to provide essential governmental services; that the provisions of  
19 this act will provide the necessary monies for the Office of Attorney General  
20 to continue such services; and that a delay in the effective date of this Act  
21 could work irreparable harm upon the proper administration and provision of  
22 essential governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared  
23 to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the  
24 public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and  
25 after the date of its passage and approval.
