SENATE BILL 36

For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE ANNOTATED §§27-23-110(a)
9 AND 27-23-111(b)(3) AS AMENDED BY ACT 36 OF THE THIRD
10 EXTRAORDINARY SESSION OF 1989 TO ALLOW A PERSON TO APPLY
11 FOR A COMMERCIAL DRIVER LICENSE RESTRICTED TO DRIVING A
12 CHURCH BUS WITHOUT PAYING AN APPLICATION FEE; AND FOR
13 OTHER PURPOSES."

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

17 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Annotated §27-23-110(a) as amended by Act 36
18 of the Third Extraordinary Session of 1989 is amended to read as follows:

19 "(a) The application for a commercial driver license or commercial
20 driver instruction permit must include the following:

21 (1) The full name and current residential address of the person;

23 (2) A physical description of the person including sex, height,
24 weight, eye color, and hair color;

25 (3) Date of birth;

26 (4) The applicant's Social Security number, unless the application
27 is for a Non-Resident CDL;

28 (5) The person's signature;

29 (6) A consent to release driving record information;

30 (7) Certifications including those required by 49 C.F.R. part
31 383.71(a);

32 (8) Any other information required by the Office of Driver
33 Services. The application must be accompanied by an application fee of sixty-
34 one dollars (\$61.00). The application fee shall not be required from a person
35 who requests that the license be restricted to the driving of a school bus,

1 church bus, or bus operated by a public transit system eligible to receive
2 federal and state assistance under programs administered through the Arkansas
3 State Highway and Transportation Department or the United States Department of
4 Transportation provided, however, that such person shall be required to pay
5 the noncommercial driver license fee."

7 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code Annotated 27-23-111(b) (3) as amended by Act 36
8 of the Third Extraordinary Session of 1989 is amended to read as follows:

9 "(b) (3) Endorsements and Restrictions.

10 'H' - authorizes the driver to drive a vehicle transporting
11 hazardous materials.

12 'K' - restricts the driver to vehicles not equipped with
13 airbrakes.

14 'T' - authorizes driving double and triple trailers.

15 'P' - authorizes driving vehicles carrying passengers or carrying
16 passengers for hire.

17 'N' - authorizes driving tank vehicles.

18 'X' - represents a combination of hazardous materials and tank
19 vehicle endorsements.

20 'M' - authorizes the driver to drive a motorcycle.

21 'S' - restricts the driver to school buses, church buses, buses
22 operated by public transit systems eligible to receive federal and state
23 assistance under programs administered through the Arkansas State Highway and
24 Transportation Department or the United States Department of Transportation,
25 and Class 'D' vehicles."

27 SECTION 3. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
28 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
29 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

31 SECTION 4. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
32 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
33 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
34 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
35 act are declared to be severable.
