# A Bill

**SENATE BILL**

## For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR PERSONAL SERVICES AND  
9 OPERATING EXPENSES FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION -  
10 EDUCATIONAL TELEVISION DIVISION FOR THE BIENNIAL PERIOD  
11 ENDING JUNE 30, 1993; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

15 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES. There is hereby established for the  
16 Department of Education - Educational Television Division for the 1991-93  
17 biennium, the following maximum number of regular employees whose salaries  
18 shall be governed by the provisions of the Uniform Classification and  
19 Compensation Act (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201 et seq.), or its successor, and all  
20 laws amendatory thereto. Provided, however, that any position to which a  
21 specific maximum annual salary is set out herein in dollars, shall be exempt  
22 from the provisions of said Uniform Classification and Compensation Act. All  
23 persons occupying positions authorized herein are hereby governed by the  
24 provisions of the Regular Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas  
25 Code §21-5-101), or its successor.

 5 SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP - STATE. There is hereby authorized, for the  
 6 Department of Education - Educational Television Division for the 1991-93  
 7 biennium, the following maximum number of part-time or temporary employees, to  
 8 be known as "Extra Help", payable from funds appropriated herein for such  
 9 purposes: Ten (10) temporary or part-time employees, when needed, at rates of  
 10 pay not to exceed those provided in the Uniform Classification and  
 11 Compensation Act, or its successor, for the appropriate classification. Many  
 12 of these positions are related to specific projects, and those positions so  
 13 related are specifically exempt from limitations of hours, either by act or  
 14 regulation.

15  
 16 SECTION 3. APPROPRIATIONS - STATE. There is hereby appropriated, to the  
 17 Department of Education - Educational Television Division, to be payable from  
 18 the Educational Television Fund Account, for personal services and operating  
 19 expenses of the Department of Education - Educational Television Division for  
 20 ~~the biennial period ending June 30, 1993, the following:~~

1 SECTION 4. EXTRA HELP - CASH. There is hereby authorized, for the  
 2 Department of Education - Educational Television Division for the 1991-93  
 3 biennium, the following maximum number of part-time or temporary employees, to  
 4 be known as "Extra Help", payable from funds appropriated herein for such  
 5 purposes: Thirty one (31) temporary or part-time employees, when needed, at  
 6 rates of pay not to exceed those provided in the Uniform Classification and  
 7 Compensation Act, or its successor, for the appropriate classification. Many  
 8 of these positions are related to specific projects, and those positions so  
 9 related are specifically exempt from limitations of hours, either by act or  
 10 regulation.

12 SECTION 5. APPROPRIATIONS - CASH. There is hereby appropriated, to the  
 13 Department of Education - Educational Television Division, to be payable from  
 14 cash funds as defined by Arkansas Code 19-4-801 of the Department of Education  
 15 - Educational Television Division, for personal services and operating  
 16 ~~expenses of the Department of Education - Educational Television Division for~~  
 17 the biennial period ending June 30, 1993, the following:

34 SECTION 6. No appropriation made available to the Educational  
 35 Television Commission or the Division of Educational Television of the

1 Department of Education shall be available until such time as the chairman of  
2 the Educational Television Commission certifies, in writing, to the  
3 Legislative Joint Auditing Committee that an audit is being conducted of the  
4 Arkansas Educational Telecommunications Network Foundation for the previous  
5 fiscal year and has promptly been made available to that committee.

6 At the end of each fiscal year, the Chairman of that Commission shall  
7 initiate an audit of the AETN Foundation by a recognized and certified public  
8 accounting firm acceptable to the Legislative Auditor with such audit  
9 standards and schedules that may be promulgated by the Legislative Auditor;  
10 such audit to be paid for by the AETN Foundation.

11 No person employed by the Arkansas ETV Commission and paid from state  
12 funds shall receive supplemental compensation or remuneration from funds not  
13 appropriated by the state.

14 State employees of the Division of Arkansas Educational Television, in  
15 fulfilling their day-to-day responsibilities, are to be supervised only by  
16 appropriate state employees and to that end, no privately funded or auxiliary  
17 funded employee or person not on the Arkansas Educational Television state  
18 payroll nor the Department of Education payroll shall supervise any state  
19 employee herein provided.

20

21 SECTION 7. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds  
22 authorized by this Act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency  
23 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and  
24 the restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and  
25 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary  
26 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control  
27 laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the  
28 Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be  
29 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

30

31 SECTION 8. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General  
32 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations  
33 contained in this Act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which  
34 this Act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive  
35 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget

1 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or  
2 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative  
3 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

4

5 SECTION 9. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent  
6 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas  
7 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

8

9 SECTION 10. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the  
10 application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such  
11 invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which  
12 can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this  
13 end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.

14

15 SECTION 11. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict  
16 with this Act are hereby repealed.

17

18 SECTION 12. HEALTH PREMIUMS. The Department of Education - Educational  
19 Television Division shall not, during the 1992-93 fiscal year, spend more for  
20 health insurance per employee than the amount being contributed to the State  
21 Employees Health Insurance Program.

22

23 SECTION 13. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the  
24 Seventy-Eighth General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of  
25 Arkansas prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year  
26 period; that the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 1991 is essential to the  
27 operation of the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided,  
28 and that in the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the  
29 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 1991 could work irreparable harm  
30 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental  
31 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act  
32 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and  
33 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 1991.
