SENATE BILL 382

For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR PERSONAL SERVICES AND
9 OPERATING EXPENSES FOR THE ARKANSAS PUBLIC SERVICE
10 COMMISSION FOR THE BIENNIAL PERIOD ENDING JUNE 30, 1993;
11 AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

15 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES - UTILITIES DIVISION. There is hereby
16 established for the Arkansas Public Service Commission - Utilities Division
17 for the 1991-93 biennium, the following maximum number of regular employees
18 whose salaries shall be governed by the provisions of the Uniform
19 Classification and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201 et seq.), or its
20 successor, and all laws amendatory thereto. Provided, however, that any
21 position to which a specific maximum annual salary is set out herein in
22 dollars, shall be exempt from the provisions of said Uniform Classification
23 and Compensation Act. All persons occupying positions authorized herein are
24 hereby governed by the provisions of the Regular Salaries Procedures and
25 Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-101), or its successor.

12 SECTION 13. CONTINGENCY RESTRICTION. In the event of unforeseen
13 conditions, additional appropriations become necessary that are not authorized
14 or contemplated in Section 3 of this Act and such events make it necessary
15 that the Public Service Commission - Utilities Division receives additional
16 appropriations to carry out the objectives of the agency, the Director of the
17 Public Service Commission is hereby authorized to request the approval of the
18 Governor and the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, as hereinafter provided,
19 for transfer of the additional appropriations provided in Section 12 to the
20 appropriations provided the Utilities Division by Section 3, but in no event
21 shall the transfers exceed the appropriations provided in Section 12 of this
22 Act. Whenever the Director of the Public Service Commission deems it
23 necessary to establish additional appropriations as authorized herein, he
24 shall file with the Governor a written report accompanied by necessary
25 supporting documents setting forth the facts, justifications, and
26 circumstances that necessitate such appropriation. Upon receipt of such
27 reports and supporting documents, the Governor, or his designee, shall study
28 the same, and if he shall determine that such additional appropriations are
29 being sought in strict compliance with this Act, the Governor, after seeking
30 prior review by the Arkansas Legislative Council or the Joint Budget
31 Committee, may approve or modify such request for additional appropriations as
32 in his judgement he deems necessary, and shall forward a copy thereof to the
33 Chief Fiscal Officer of the State. Upon receipt thereof, the Chief Fiscal
34 Officer of the State shall direct the State Auditor to process said transfer
35 upon his books in accordance with the provisions as set out therein.

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2 SECTION 14. SPECIAL RATES OF PAY. Due to the highly competitive job
 3 market conditions for utility rate case professionals and the necessity of
 4 recruiting and retaining qualified personnel, the Public Service Commission is
 5 authorized special rates of pay for current and new employees in the
 6 classification listed under subsection (a) below.

7 (a) Special rates may be authorized up to the maximum authorized for the
 8 grade assigned the classification of a position for the following specific

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7 (b) A monthly report shall be made to the Arkansas Legislative Council
8 describing all personnel transactions involving applications of any of the
9 provisions of this Section.

10 (c) This provision shall be in full force and effect for the biennium
11 beginning July 1, 1991, and ending June 30, 1993.

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13 SECTION 15. CARRY FORWARD. Any unexpended balance of the appropriation
14 authorized in Item (07) of Section 3 of this Act which remains at the close of
15 the fiscal year ending June 30, 1992, shall be carried forward and made
16 available for the same purpose for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1993.

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18 SECTION 16. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized
19 by this Act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds
20 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the
21 restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary
22 Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures
23 and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of
24 this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of
25 Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied
26 with in disbursement of said funds.

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28 SECTION 17. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly
29 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained
30 in this Act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this Act
31 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations
32 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by
33 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral
34 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint
35 Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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SECTION 18. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

SECTION 19. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.

SECTION 20. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.

SECTION 21. HEALTH PREMIUMS. The Arkansas Public Service Commission shall not, during the 1992-93 fiscal year, spend more for health insurance per employee than the amount being contributed to the State Employees Health Insurance Program.

SECTION 22. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the Seventy-Eighth General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 1991 is essential to the operation of the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 1991 could work irreparable harm upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 1991.
