18 SECTION 54. Two of the R266 Management Project Analyst II Grade 20 19 positions authorized in Section 28 of this Act shall be financed by the 20 increase in the Real Estate Transfer Tax enacted by the 76th General Assembly 21 and made available to the Arkansas Natural and Cultural Resources Council for 22 the "Main Street" Program.

SECTION 55. TRANSFER OF STATE FUNDS - HISTORIC PRESERVATION PROGRAM. Subject to such rules and regulations as may be implemented by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State and after seeking prior review by the Arkansas Legislative Council, the Historic Preservation Officer is hereby authorized to transfer funds and appropriations for Regular Salaries; Personal Services Matching (Social Security, Retirement, Workmen's Compensation and Unemployment Insurance) Maintenance and Operations; Grants; Conference Fees and Travel; Professional Services; and Extra Help; under the various sections in this Act which appropriate State Funds, whenever it appears by projecting the expenditures of any of these appropriations that there will be a need of funds or appropriations in one item and that there is an excess of funds or appropriations in another item. 35 SECTION 61. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds

1 authorized by this Act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency 2 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and 3 the restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and 4 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary 5 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control 6 laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the 7 Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be 8 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

9

10 SECTION 62. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General 11 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations 12 contained in this Act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which 13 this Act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive 14 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget 15 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or 16 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative 17 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

19 SECTION 63. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and 20 permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and 21 the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code. 22

23 SECTION 64. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the 24 application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such 25 invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which 26 can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this 27 end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.

28

29 SECTION 65. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict 30 with this Act are hereby repealed.

31

32 SECTION 66. HEALTH PREMIUMS. The Department of Arkansas Heritage shall 33 not, during the 1992-93 fiscal year, spend more for health insurance per 34 employee than the amount being contributed to the State Employees Health 35 Insurance Program.

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2	SECTION 67. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the
3	Seventy-Eighth General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of
4	Arkansas prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year
5	period; that the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 1991 is essential to the
6	operation of the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided,
7	and that in the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the
8	effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 1991 could work irreparable harm
9	upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental
10	programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act
11	being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
12	safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 1991.
