SENATE BILL

For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE 23-78-108(a) RELATING TO
9 THE AUTHORITY OF THE BURIAL ASSOCIATION BOARD IN
10 ESTABLISHING RATES AND RESERVE REQUIREMENTS; AND FOR OTHER
11 PURPOSES."

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

15 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 23-78-108(a) is amended to read as follows:

16 "(a) The Burial Association Board appointed pursuant to this chapter
17 shall have full and complete authority to:

18 (1) Grant certificates of authority to burial associations;

19 (2) Revoke certificates of authority, charters, or other
20 authority granted to burial associations in this state;

21 (3) Fix the minimum assessments or minimum membership dues for
22 which burial associations may issue certificates for benefits in specified
23 amounts;

24 (4) Supervise the affairs of all burial associations organized or
25 operating in this state;

26 (5) Conduct hearings as provided in this chapter and collect,
27 receive, hold, and expend annual license fees as provided in this chapter;

28 (6) Adopt and enforce such rules and regulations as it may deem
29 necessary and expedient for the proper operation of the board and the carrying
30 out of the objects and purposes of this chapter; and

31 (7) Establish rates and reserve requirements ."

33 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
34 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
35 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this act are declared to be severable.

SECTION 4. All laws or parts of laws in conflict with this act are hereby repealed.
