SECTION 22. DISBURSEMENT CONTROLS. (A) No contract may be awarded nor obligations otherwise incurred in relation to the project or projects described herein in excess of the State Treasury funds actually available therefor as provided by law. Provided, however, that institutions and agencies listed herein shall have the authority to accept and use grants and donations including Federal funds, and to use its unobligated cash income or funds, or both available to it, for the purpose of supplementing the State Treasury funds for financing the entire costs of the project or projects enumerated herein. Provided further, that the appropriations and funds otherwise provided by the General Assembly for Maintenance and General Operations of the agency or institutions receiving appropriation herein shall not be used for any of the purposes as appropriated in this Act.

(B) Any restrictions contained in the Acts enumerated in the reappropriation sections of this Act, the restrictions of any applicable provisions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law and any other applicable fiscal control laws of this State and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in disbursement of any funds provided by this Act unless specifically

3	SECTION 23. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
4	Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
5	contained in this Act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which
6	this Act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
7	Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
8	manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
9	summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
10	Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.
11	
12	SECTION 24. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent
13	nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas
14	Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.
15	
16	SECTION 25. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the
17	application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such
18	invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which
19	can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this
20	end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.
21	
22	SECTION 26. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict
23	with this Act are hereby repealed.
24
