SENATE BILL 630

For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO CLARIFY THE LAW RELATING TO THE SCHOOL MILLAGE
9 TO BE LEVIED IN SCHOOL DISTRICTS WHICH ARE FORMED AS A
10 RESULT OF CONSOLIDATION, ANNEXATION, OR MERGER OF ALL OR
11 PARTS OF TWO OR MORE DISTRICTS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

14
15 SECTION 1. When a new school district is created from all or parts of
16 two or more districts or a district is dissolved and all or part of the area
17 of the dissolved district is annexed to or consolidated with an existing
18 district, the board of directors of the resulting district shall submit to the
19 electors of the district at the next annual school election a proposed tax
20 millage rate for the district. If the proposed millage rate is approved by
21 the electors of the district, it shall be the rate for the district. If the
22 electors fail to approve the proposed millage rate, the millage rate for the
23 district shall be the millage rate levied at the preceding school election in
24 the district which had the highest average daily membership during the
25 preceding school year.

26
27 SECTION 2. The provisions of this act shall be applicable with respect
28 to millages to be levied in 1991 for collection in 1992, and thereafter.

29
30 SECTION 3. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
31 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
32 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

33
34 SECTION 4. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
35 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect

1 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
2 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
3 act are declared to be severable.

5 SECTION 5. Arkansas Code 26-80-111 and all other laws and parts of laws
6 in conflict with this act are hereby repealed.

8 SECTION 6. *This Act shall become effective on October 1, 1991.*
