SENATE BILL

For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE ARKANSAS CHILD
9 ABUSE/DOMESTIC VIOLENCE COMMISSION THROUGH THE OFFICE OF
10 PROSECUTOR COORDINATOR FOR THE BIENNIAL PERIOD ENDING JUNE
11 30, 1993; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

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13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

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15 SECTION 1. APPROPRIATIONS - CHILD ABUSE/DOMESTIC VIOLENCE COMMISSION.
16 There is hereby appropriated, to the Office of Prosecutor Coordinator, to be
17 payable from the State Central Services Fund, for operating expenses of the
18 Child Abuse/Domestic Violence Commission for the biennial period ending June
19 30, 1993, the following:

33 SECTION 2. APPROPRIATIONS - CHILDRENS JUSTICE ACT. There is hereby
34 appropriated, to the Office of Prosecutor Coordinator, to be payable from the
35 federal funds as designated by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, for

1 grants under the Childrens Justice Act by the Child Abuse/Domestic Violence
2 Commission, the sum of \$158,000.

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4 SECTION 3. APPROPRIATIONS - FAMILY VIOLENCE PREVENTION AND SERVICES ACT.

5 There is hereby appropriated, to the Office of Prosecutor Coordinator, to be
6 payable from the federal funds as designated by the Chief Fiscal Officer of
7 the State, for grants under the Family Violence Prevention and Services Act by
8 the Child Abuse/Domestic Violence Commission, the sum of \$68,000.

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10 SECTION 4. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds

11 authorized by this Act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency
12 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and
13 the restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and
14 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
15 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control
16 laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the
17 Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
18 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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20 SECTION 5. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General

21 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
22 contained in this Act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which
23 this Act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
24 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
25 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
26 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
27 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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29 SECTION 6. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent

30 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas
31 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

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33 SECTION 7. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the

34 application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such
35 invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which

1 can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this
2 end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.

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4 SECTION 8. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict
5 with this Act are hereby repealed.

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7 SECTION 9. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the
8 Seventy-Eighth General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of
9 Arkansas prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year
10 period; that the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 1991 is essential to the
11 operation of the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided,
12 and that in the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the
13 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 1991 could work irreparable harm
14 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental
15 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act
16 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
17 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 1991.

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
