SENATE BILL 680

For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR PERSONAL SERVICES AND
9 OPERATING EXPENSES FOR THE OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR FOR THE
10 BIENNIAL PERIOD ENDING JUNE 30, 1993; AND FOR OTHER
11 PURPOSES."

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

15 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES. There is hereby established for the
16 Office of the Governor for the 1991-93 biennium, the following maximum number
17 of regular employees whose salaries shall be governed by the provisions of the
18 Uniform Classification and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201 et
19 seq.), or its successor, and all laws amendatory thereto. Provided, however,
20 that any position to which a specific maximum annual salary is set out herein
21 in dollars, shall be exempt from the provisions of said Uniform Classification
22 and Compensation Act. All persons occupying positions authorized herein are
23 hereby governed by the provisions of the Regular Salaries Procedures and
24 Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-101), or its successor.

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20 SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP. There is hereby authorized, for the Office
 21 of the Governor for the 1991-93 biennium, the following maximum number of
 22 part-time or temporary employees, to be known as "Extra Help", payable from
 23 funds appropriated herein for such purposes: five (5) temporary or part-time
 24 employees, when needed, at rates of pay not to exceed those provided in the
 25 Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, or its successor, or this act for
 26 the appropriate classification.

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28 SECTION 3. APPROPRIATIONS. There is hereby appropriated, to the Office
 29 of the Governor, to be payable from the State Central Services Fund, for
 30 personal services and operating expenses of the Office of the Governor for the
 31 biennial period ending June 30, 1993, the following:

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11 SECTION 4. *There is hereby appropriated, to the Office of the Governor,*
12 *to be payable from the Miscellaneous Revolving Fund, for the purposes provided*
13 *for by Arkansas Code 19-2-404 which shall be supplemental and in addition to*
14 *those funds appropriated in Section 1 of Act 115 of 1991 for the fiscal year*
15 *ending June 30, 1992 the sum of\$2,000,000.*

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17 SECTION 5. TRANSFER PROVISIONS. Any unexpended balance of
18 appropriation provided in this Act, excluding Regular Salaries, which remains
19 at the close of the fiscal year ending June 30, 1992, shall be transferred
20 forward and made available for the same purpose for the fiscal year ending
21 June 30, 1993.

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23 SECTION 6. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds
24 authorized by this Act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency
25 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and
26 the restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and
27 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
28 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control
29 laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the
30 Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
31 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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33 SECTION 7. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
34 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
35 contained in this Act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which
36 this Act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive

1 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
2 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
3 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
4 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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6 SECTION 8. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent
7 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas
8 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

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10 SECTION 9. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the
11 application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such
12 invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which
13 can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this
14 end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.

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16 SECTION 10. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict
17 with this Act are hereby repealed.

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19 SECTION 11. HEALTH PREMIUMS. The Office of the Governor shall not,
20 during the 1992-93 fiscal year, spend more for health insurance per employee
21 than the amount being contributed to the State Employees Health Insurance
22 Program.

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24 SECTION 12. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the
25 Seventy-Eighth General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of
26 Arkansas prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year
27 period; that the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 1991 is essential to the
28 operation of the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided,
29 and that in the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the
30 effective date of this act beyond July 1, 1991 could work irreparable harm
31 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental
32 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act
33 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
34 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 1991.
