SENATE BILL

For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO REQUIRE THE STATE POLICE TO CONDUCT HAZARDOUS
9 MATERIAL EVACUATION DRILLS IN ALL PUBLIC SCHOOLS AT LEAST
10 NINE (9) TIMES DURING EVERY SCHOOL YEAR; AND FOR OTHER
11 PURPOSES."

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

15 SECTION 1. The Arkansas State Police shall conduct hazardous material
16 evacuation drills in every public school of this State nine (9) times during
17 each school year. The purpose of the drill is to accustom students, faculty
18 and other employees to proper evacuation procedures in case of a hazardous
19 material spill which could endanger the occupants of school buildings. The
20 State Police shall give a monthly report to the school superintendents and
21 quarterly reports to the Department of Education.

23 SECTION 2. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent nature
24 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
25 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

26
27 SECTION 3. If any provision of this Act or the application thereof to
28 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
29 other provisions or applications of the Act which can be given effect without
30 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
31 Act are declared to be severable.

33 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are
34 hereby repealed.
