**SENATE BILL**

## For An Act To Be Entitled

7 "AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE 19-4-903 TO INCREASE THE  
8 DAILY ALLOWANCES FOR MEALS AND LODGING FOR ANY INDIVIDUAL  
9 TRAVELER SHALL NOT EXCEED THE SUM OF FIFTY-FIVE DOLLARS  
10 (\$55.00) PER DAY WHILE TRAVELING WITHIN THE STATE, NOR THE  
11 SUM OF SIXTY-FIVE DOLLARS (\$65.00) PER DAY WHILE TRAVELING  
12 OUTSIDE THE STATE; TO ALLOW THAT REIMBURSEMENT FOR THE USE  
13 OF PRIVATELY OWNED MOTOR VEHICLES WHILE TRAVELING ON  
14 OFFICIAL BUSINESS FOR THE STATE SHALL NOT EXCEED THE  
15 ALLOWABLE RATE OF THE INTERNAL REVENUE SERVICE PER MILE;  
16 AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

21 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 19-4-903 (a)(1) is hereby amended to read as  
22 follows:

23 "(a)(1) Except for special authorization, executed by the board,  
24 commission, or administrative head of any state agency setting out the reasons  
25 therefore, the daily allowances for meals and lodging for any individual  
26 traveler shall not exceed the sum of fifty-five dollars (\$55.00) per day while  
27 traveling within the state, nor the sum of sixty-five dollars (\$65.00) per day  
28 while traveling outside the state."

30 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code 19-4-903(a)(3)(b)(1)(A) is hereby amended to  
31 read as follows:

32 "(a)(3)(b)(1)(A) Unless otherwise provided for by law, reimbursement for  
33 the use of privately owned motor vehicles while traveling on official business  
34 for the state shall not exceed the allowable rate of the Internal Revenue  
35 Service per mile for business use of privately owned motor vehicles."

3 SECTION 3. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent  
4 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas  
5 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

7 SECTION 4. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the  
8 application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such  
9 invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which  
10 can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this  
11 end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.

12

13 SECTION 5. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict  
14 with this Act are hereby repealed.

15

16 SECTION 6. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the  
17 Seventy-Eighth General Assembly, that due to the increased cost of travel, the  
18 rate of reimbursement for use of privately owned motor vehicles needs to be  
19 increased; that due to the increase in the cost of meals and lodging borne by  
20 employees of the State of Arkansas, the per diem needs to be increased.  
21 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being  
22 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and  
23 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its  
24 passage and approval.
