SENATE BILL

For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE 17-23-210, RELATING TO THE
9 DISPOSITION OF FUNDS DEPOSITED IN THE COSMETOLOGY
10 CONTINGENT FUND; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

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12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

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14 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Annotated Section 17-23-210 is hereby amended
15 to read as follows:

16 "Section 1. 17-23-210. Disposition of Funds.

17 (a) All fees collected on behalf of the board and all receipts of
18 every kind and nature shall be paid into the State Treasury and shall be
19 credited to the Board of Cosmetology Contingent Fund. The contingent fund
20 shall be for the general uses of the board and out of it shall be paid all
21 salaries and all other expenses necessarily incurred in carrying into effect
22 the provisions of this chapter. Expenditures from the contingent fund shall
23 be substantiated by vouchers and itemized statements at the end of each fiscal
24 year or at any other time when demand therefor is made by the Department of
25 Finance and Administration.

26 (b) The unencumbered balance of the revenues remaining in the
27 Cosmetology Contingent Fund on June 30, 1991 together with the excess of any
28 revenues deposited in the said fund for each fiscal year thereafter shall
29 remain in the Cosmetology Contingent Fund and shall be used by the board as
30 provided in subsection (a) of this section. The Cosmetology Construction
31 Fund shall be used by the board for construction or purchase of facilities for
32 the use of the board, as in their discretion is deemed necessary to further
33 the ends of this chapter.

34 (c) The Board of Cosmetology, upon notification to the Chief Fiscal
35 Officer of the State on July 1 of each year, may transfer an amount not to

1 exceed one-half (1/2) of the annual operating budget of the Board of
2 Cosmetology from the Cosmetology Construction Fund to the Board of Cosmetology
3 Contingent Fund, there to be used for operating expenses for the Board of
4 Cosmetology for the first six (6) months of each fiscal year. The amount
5 shall be repaid on or before June 30 of each fiscal year from current revenues
6 received by the Board of Cosmetology."

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8 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
9 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
10 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

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12 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
13 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
14 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
15 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
16 act are declared to be severable.

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18 SECTION 4. All laws or parts of laws in conflict with this act are
19 hereby repealed.

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
