7 **SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION**

8 REQUESTING THE JOINT INTERIM COMMITTEE ON STATE AGENCIES
9 AND GOVERNMENTAL AFFAIRS TO CONDUCT A STUDY OF THE
10 FEASIBILITY OF ESTABLISHING A COMPUTERIZED STATE-WIDE
11 VOTER REGISTRATION SYSTEM.

13 WHEREAS, voter registration lists are maintained on the county level and
14 the state does not have a centralized listing of all registered voters; and

15 WHEREAS, the lack of a state-wide list hampers the administration of the
16 election laws; and

17 WHEREAS, a state-wide computerized list of registered voters would
18 assist the Secretary of State in verifying the sufficiency of initiative and
19 referendum petitions,

21 NOW THEREFORE,

22 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE SEVENTY-EIGHTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE
23 STATE OF ARKANSAS, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN:

25 That the Joint Interim Committee on State Agencies and Governmental
26 Affairs is requested to conduct an interim study of the feasibility and cost
27 of establishing a computerized system for maintaining a state-wide voter
28 registration list. The committee is requested to make its findings and
29 recommendations to the Seventy-Ninth General Assembly.
