SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

7 COMMENDING ARKANSAS FARMERS FOR THEIR MANY ESSENTIAL
8 CONTRIBUTIONS TO THE SECURITY AND ECONOMIC WELL-BEING OF
9 THE STATE AND THE NATION, AND FOR PRODUCING THE FOOD AND
10 FIBER THAT IS ESSENTIAL TO THE HEALTH AND SECURITY OF THE

14 WHEREAS, the economy of the State of Arkansas depends greatly on
15 agriculture and related activities and industries; and

17 WHEREAS, the farmers of the State not only produce the food and fiber
18 that is essential to the health and security of the citizens of this State and
19 people throughout the world, but also provide a source of employment for a
20 large percentage of the residents of this State; and

22 WHEREAS, our national security and the welfare of our military personnel
23 at home and overseas depend on plentiful food supplies; and

25 WHEREAS, agricultural pursuits in the State produce annual wealth in
26 excess of three-point-eight-billion dollars and contribute immeasurably to the
27 stable and well-balanced economy of the State; and

29 WHEREAS, many farmers in the State continue to pursue their agricultural
30 endeavors in the face of an uncertain economy at home and war and unrest
31 abroad; and

33 WHEREAS, a substantial portion of the State's revenues which are
34 necessary to finance essential State and local programs and services are
35 derived from agricultural and related activities; and

2 WHEREAS, Arkansas farmers are deserving of public commendation and
3 appreciation,

5 NOW THEREFORE,

6 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE SEVENTY-EIGHTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE
7 STATE OF ARKANSAS, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN:
