## **SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION**

7 PROPOSING AN AMENDMENT TO THE ARKANSAS CONSTITUTION TO  
8 PROHIBIT THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY FROM INCREASING OR  
9 DECREASING THE RATE OF ANY TAX NOW OR HEREAFTER ENACTED,  
10 OR OTHERWISE AMENDING OR REPEALING ANY PROVISIONS OF ANY  
11 LAW LEVYING A TAX EXCEPT UPON THE VOTE OF TWO-THIRDS (2/3)  
12 OF THE TOTAL MEMBERSHIP OF EACH HOUSE.

14 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE SEVENTY-EIGHTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE  
15 STATE OF ARKANSAS AND BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES, A MAJORITY OF ALL  
16 MEMBERS ELECTED TO EACH HOUSE AGREEING THERETO:

18 That the following is hereby proposed as an amendment to the Constitution  
19 of the state of Arkansas, and upon being submitted to the electors of the  
20 state for approval or rejection at the next general election for Senators and  
21 Representatives, if a majority of the electors voting thereon at such  
22 election, adopt such amendment, the same shall become a part of the  
23 Constitution of the state of Arkansas, to wit:

25 SECTION 1. The General Assembly shall not, after December 31, 1992,  
26 increase or decrease the rate of any tax, nor otherwise amend or repeal any  
27 provisions of any law levying a tax, except upon the affirmative vote of two-  
28 thirds (2/3) of the total membership of each house of the General Assembly.

30 SECTION 2. This Amendment shall become effective January 1, 1993.

32 SECTION 3. Section 38 of Article 5 of the Constitution of the State of  
33 Arkansas as added thereto by Section 2 of Amendment 19 to the Constitution of  
34 the State of Arkansas is hereby repealed.
