8 CONGRATULATING THE TWENTY-ONE ARKANSAS ELEMENTARY AND  
9 SECONDARY SCHOOL TEACHERS WHO RECEIVED AWARDS AT THE 1989-  
10 90 NATIONAL AWARDS PROGRAM FOR THE TEACHING OF ECONOMICS.

12 WHEREAS, twenty-one Arkansas elementary and secondary school teachers  
13 received awards at the 1989-90 National Awards Program for the Teaching of  
14 Economics; and

15 WHEREAS, these teachers represent excellence in the classroom; and

16 WHEREAS, these teachers now join three hundred and thirty-three other  
17 Arkansas teachers who are previous winners in this program over the past  
18 twenty-nine years; and

19 WHEREAS, Arkansas ranks number one in the nation in the number of  
20 teachers who have won national awards for the teaching of economics; and

21 WHEREAS, last year Arkansas was the only state in the nation with two  
22 first place winners;

25 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE SEVENTY-EIGHTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE
