## **SENATE RESOLUTION**

8       TO URGE THE ARKANSAS DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION AND THE  
9       PUBLIC SCHOOL DISTRICTS IN THIS STATE TO INCLUDE  
10      ENVIRONMENTAL EDUCATION IN ALL APPROPRIATE DISCIPLINES.

16       WHEREAS, issues concerning destruction of rain forests, loss of animal  
17 and plant species, global warming, population explosion and toxic wastes are  
18 becoming more and more prevalent; and

20       WHEREAS, resolution of these problems will require an informed populous  
21 with knowledge in environmental issues which transgress all traditional  
22 curricula; and

24       WHEREAS, the students of today will be the persons called upon to help  
25 solve these monumental problems in the environment of tomorrow; and

27       WHEREAS, it is the responsibility of educators to adequately equip those  
28 citizens with knowledge and information to become responsive to the ecological  
29 problems and environmental concerns of this world;
