## **SENATE RESOLUTION**

7  
8 REQUESTING THE ARKANSAS PARKS, RECREATION AND TRAVEL  
9 COMMISSION TO CONDUCT A STUDY OF THE FEASIBILITY OF  
10 INCORPORATING THE CONFEDERATE CEMETERY OF FAYETTEVILLE  
11 INTO THE STATE PARK SYSTEM.

13 WHEREAS, the Confederate Cemetery of Fayetteville has been an important  
14 historical site for more than a century and remains one of Fayetteville's  
15 significant tourist attractions, and

16 WHEREAS, the cemetery was founded by the Southern Memorial Association  
17 whose membership has declined, thereby making proper maintenance difficult,  
18 and

19 WHEREAS, the Southern Memorial Association is to be commended for the  
20 care it has provided through the years which has preserved the cemetery since  
21 its inception in 1872, and

22 WHEREAS, the Southern Memorial Association has now joined with the Sons  
23 of Confederate Veterans to place the cemetery under the Arkansas Department of  
24 Parks, Recreation and Travel,

26 NOW THEREFORE,

27 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE SEVENTY-EIGHTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE  
28 STATE OF ARKANSAS:

30 That the State Parks, Recreation and Travel Commission is hereby requested to  
31 conduct a study of the feasibility of designating the Confederate Cemetery in  
32 Fayetteville as a state park or of incorporating it as a part of the Prairie  
33 Grove Battlefield State Park. The study shall also determine the additional  
34 cost to the State for each option and the Commission is requested to report  
35 its findings to the Joint Interim Committee on State Agencies and Governmental
