HOUSE BILL

For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO PROHIBIT THE TRANSPORTING OF SAND, GRAVEL, OR
9 ROCK IN MOTOR VEHICLES OR TRAILERS WITH AN OPEN BED UNLESS
10 THE OPEN BED IS SECURELY COVERED; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

Subtitle

13 "AN ACT TO PROHIBIT THE TRANSPORTING OF SAND, GRAVEL, OR
14 ROCK IN MOTOR VEHICLES OR TRAILERS WITH AN OPEN BED UNLESS
15 IT IS SECURELY COVERED."

17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

18
19 SECTION 1. No sand, gravel, or rock shall be transported on the public
20 streets and highways of this State in a motor vehicle or trailer with an open
21 bed unless the open bed is securely covered with a material which will prevent
22 the load from spilling or otherwise escaping.

23
24 SECTION 2. Any person who pleads guilty, nolo contendere, or is found
25 guilty of operating a motor vehicle in violation of this act shall be guilty
26 of a misdemeanor and shall be fined not less than one hundred dollars
27 (\$100.00) nor more than five hundred dollars (\$500.00).

28
29 SECTION 3. All provisions of this act of general and permanent nature
30 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
31 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

33 SECTION 4. If any provisions of this act or the application thereof to
34 any person or circumstance is held invalid, the invalidity shall not affect
35 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without

1 the invalid provisions or application, and to this end the provisions of this
2 act are declared to be severable.

4 SECTION 5. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
5 hereby repealed.
