## 7 **For An Act To Be Entitled**

8 "AN ACT TO PROHIBIT ANY PERSON OPERATING A PICKUP TRUCK OR  
9 FLATBED TRUCK OR TOWING A FLATBED TRAILER ON A PUBLIC  
10 STREET OR HIGHWAY WHEN A CHILD NINE (9) YEARS OF AGE OR  
11 YOUNGER IS OCCUPYING THE OPEN BED OF THE TRUCK OR TRAILER;  
12 TO AMEND ARK. CODE § 27-35-104 BY STRIKING ONE EXCEPTION  
13 TO THE PROHIBITION AGAINST PERSONS RIDING ON ANY PORTION  
14 OF A VEHICLE NOT INTENDED FOR PASSENGER USE; TO AMEND ARK.  
15 CODE §§ 27-34-103 AND -104 RELATING TO CHILD PASSENGER  
16 PROTECTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

## 18 **Subtitle**

19 "AN ACT TO PROHIBIT PERSONS OPERATING PICKUP TRUCKS OR  
20 FLATBED TRUCKS OR TRAILERS WHEN CHILDREN AGE 9 OR YOUNGER  
21 ARE OCCUPYING THE OPEN TRUCK OR TRAILER BED."

23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

24

25 SECTION 1. (a) No person shall operate an open bed pickup truck or an  
26 open flatbed truck or shall tow an open flatbed trailer on a public street or  
27 highway when a child nine (9) years of age or younger is occupying the bed or  
28 cargo area of the truck or trailer.

29 (b) A violation of this section is punishable by a fine of not less  
30 than twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) nor more than two hundred dollars (\$200).

31 (c) The provisions of this section shall not apply when the person is  
32 operating or towing the vehicle in an emergency or *participating in a parade*  
33 *as authorized by a city or county.*

34

35 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 27-34-104(a) is hereby amended to read as

1 follows:

2         "(a) Every driver who transports a child under the age of five (5)  
3 years in a passenger automobile, van, or pickup truck shall provide, while the  
4 motor vehicle is in motion and operated on a public *street* or highway of this  
5 state, for the protection of the child by properly placing, maintaining, and  
6 securing the child in a child passenger safety seat system meeting applicable  
7 federal motor vehicle safety standards in effect on August 1, 1983."

8

9             SECTION 3. Arkansas Code 27-34-103(a) is hereby amended to read as  
10 follows:

11         "(a) Any person who violates this chapter shall, upon conviction, be  
12 fined not less than twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) nor more than two hundred  
13 dollars (\$200.00)."

14

15             SECTION 4. Arkansas Code § 27-35-104 is hereby amended to read as  
16 follows:

17         "27-35-104. Riding in spaces not for passengers.

18         (a) No person shall ride on any vehicle or upon any portion of the  
19 vehicle, including the cargo area, *that is* not designed or intended for the  
20 use of passengers.

21         (b) *This section shall not apply to any individual engaged in the  
22 necessary discharge of a duty, either for an employer, or for private  
23 purposes.*"

24

25             SECTION 5. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature  
26 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code  
27 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

28

29             SECTION 6. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to  
30 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect  
31 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without  
32 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this  
33 act are declared to be severable.

35             SECTION 7. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are

1 hereby repealed.
