9 "AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT 51,
10 SECTION 11 TO ALLOW THE PERMANENT REGISTRAR TO CANCEL THE
11 REGISTRATION OF VOTERS WHO HAVE CHANGED THEIR RESIDENCE
12 WITHIN THE COUNTY AND HAVE NOT NOTIFIED THE PERMANENT
13 REGISTRAR OF THE NEW ADDRESS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

16 "TO ALLOW THE PERMANENT REGISTRAR TO CANCEL THE
17 REGISTRATION OF VOTERS WHO HAVE CHANGED THEIR RESIDENCE
18 WITHIN THE COUNTY."

20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

22 SECTION 1. Section 11(a) of Amendment 51 of the Arkansas Constitution
23 is hereby amended to read as follows:

24 "(a) It shall be the duty of the Permanent Registrar to cancel the
25 registration of voters:

26 (1) Who have failed to vote in any election during four (4)
27 successive calendar years immediately preceding the first of January of any
28 year;

29 (2) Who have changed their residence to an address outside the
30 county;

31 (3) Who have died or changed their name;

32 (4) Who have been convicted of felonies and have not discharged
33 their sentence or been pardoned;

34 (5) Who are not lawfully qualified or registered electors of this
35 state, or of the county; or
