8 "AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE 5-63-201 TO PROHIBIT
9 SCALPING OF TICKETS FOR MUSIC ENTERTAINMENT EVENTS; AND
10 FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

13 "TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE 5-63-201 TO PROHIBIT
14 SCALPING OF TICKETS FOR MUSIC ENTERTAINMENT
15 EVENTS."

17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

18

19 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code §5-63-201(a) is amended to read as follows:

20 "(a) It shall be unlawful for any person, corporation, firm, or
21 partnership to sell or offer for sale any tickets to high school, college
22 athletic events or any music entertainment events at a greater price than that
23 *printed on the ticket plus any charge for credit card use or the box office*
24 *sale price plus any charge for credit card use, whichever is the greater.* This
25 subsection shall not apply to institutions of higher education which receive
26 funds per ticket above the face value of that ticket."

27

28 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
29 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
30 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

31

32 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
33 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
34 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
35 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this

1 act are declared to be severable.

3 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
4 hereby repealed.
