HOUSE BILL 1086

For An Act To Be Entitled

9 "AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT AN APPEAL TO CONTEST THE RESULTS
10 OF ANY ELECTION IN ANY COURT OF THIS STATE SHALL BE FILED
11 WITHIN SEVEN (7) CALENDAR DAYS OF THE FINAL CERTIFICATION
12 OF THE ELECTION."

Subtitle

14 "TO PROVIDE THAT AN APPEAL OF ELECTION RESULTS SHALL BE
15 FILED WITHIN SEVEN DAYS OF FINAL CERTIFICATION OF THE
16 ELECTION."

19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

21 SECTION 1. An appeal to contest the results of any election in any
22 court of this state, must be filed within seven (7) calendar days of the final
23 certification of the election result except in instances where the
24 Constitution establishes a time frame for filing an appeal.

26 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
27 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
28 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

29
30 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
31 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
32 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
33 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
34 act are declared to be severable.

1 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
2 hereby repealed.
