# A Bill

**HOUSE BILL 1230**

## For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE 5-39-202 TO PROVIDE THAT  
9 THE UNLAWFUL BREAKING OR ENTERING INTO A COIN OPERATED  
10 AMUSEMENT OR VENDING MACHINE OR A FARE BOX ON A BUS IS A  
11 CLASS D FELONY; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

## Subtitle

14 "MAKING THE UNLAWFUL BREAKING OR ENTERING INTO A COIN  
15 OPERATED AMUSEMENT OR VENDING MACHINE A CLASS D FELONY."

17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

19 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 5-39-202 is hereby amended to read as follows:

20 "§5-39-202. Breaking or entering.

21 (a) A person commits the offense of breaking or entering if for the  
22 purpose of committing a theft or felony he enters or breaks into any building,  
23 structure, vehicle, vault, safe, cash register, money vending machine, coin-  
24 operated amusement or vending machine, product dispenser, money depository,  
25 safety deposit box, coin telephone, coin box, fare box on a bus, or other  
26 similar container, apparatus, or equipment.

27 (b) The breaking or entering into of each separate building,  
28 structure, vehicle, vault, safe, cash register, money vending machine, coin-  
29 operated amusement or vending machine, product dispenser, money depository,  
30 safety deposit box, coin telephone, coin box, fare box on a bus, or other  
31 similar container, apparatus or equipment shall constitute a separate offense  
32 under this act.

33 (c) Breaking or entering is a Class D felony."

35 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature

1 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code  
2 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

4 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to  
5 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect  
6 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without  
7 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this  
8 act are declared to be severable.

9

10 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are  
11 hereby repealed.
